General Club Business

Meeting with Rushmoor Borough Council

Dave and Martin had a meeting with Rushmoor Borough Council with regard to how to proceed with the Variation to Permission Licence on the Planning. It discussed that we apply for an extension to 12 midnight for a six months period. The application will be completed and applied for by the end of next week.

A temporary tens licence has been applied for the 27th December as the Farnborough North End team has had a game re-arranged from 24th December to 27th December and our current licence does not cover the bar being open on a Tuesday currently.

We are applying to have the clause deleted from the alcohol licence to allow people to drink from bottles if they so wish.

Disability Team – The new Disability Team that has joined Rushmoor is called Rushmoor Community Forresters. They play and train on a Tuesday and had their first game on Tuesday 6th December. Pat and Dave Austin currently open up and offer refreshment and snacks for sale. At present there is no cost to the club as the team is using an old kit which is surplus to requirements for any of the other current Rushmoor Community teams. Over the next few months we will monitor any cost and review the situation accordingly.

Steve Read, Sue Carter and the ladies running the disability team are looking to take the Disability Level 1 Coach Certificate. The ladies who run the team have the Mentally Disability Level 1 Certificate.

This will cover one more point on our five year development plan.

Lee Bishop Under 8's Hawks everything is going well with the Hawks. Waiting for some Jackets which Martin is sorting out.

Gavin Scott & Darren Miles – Under 6's Couple of friendly games which have gone well. Waiting Jackets for the team which Martin is sorting out. Inflatable goals have some caps missing – Martin will get some from the spares box and purchase a few pumps.

Kevin Wiltshire Under 14's team is progressing nicely.

Graham Denny Under 11's Colts – In the quarter finals of Hampshire Cup away to Fareham. Has attended his Safeguarding Children course and waiting certificate. Have had a referee in a league game which both him and Darren Barnard of Curly Park refused to mark the referee as they felt he was incompetent. They have both logged a complaint with Gordon Vince and he said referee is currently being mentored. Mark Glanville is going to help Graham Denny with a couple of training sessions.

Steve Boniface Under 15's – is waiting delivery of a couple of football shirts.

John Tunicliffe and Peter Down Under 10's Meteors – The respect barriers still not being put up or put away properly. Can Martin re-send the respect barrier map to all managers and coaches and put up a map in the club house so everyone has access to the correct information. Also in the Quarter Finals of the Cup.

Lawrence Atrill Under 9's - is progressing have lost some and won some. Match reports have appeared in the Aldershot News as Lawrence has a contact there. Lawrence will e-mail David Austin the e-mail address to send match reports to Aldershot News. The reports have to be 50 words or less and will only appear if they do not have much on Farnborough or Aldershot Football League Clubs.

John Doyle Under 9's – John has passed his Level 1 and will let Steve Read have the certificate. Has had one player drop out.

Alex Dynes – Under 10's has one player they feel they may lose due to him not being played all the time. They run their team on a fair and equal basis that everyone is subbed. Will wait on any further developments.

Carol Glanville Welfare Officer – CRB are still being processed for a couple of coaches. A couple more managers and coaches have CRB form but yet to hand them in. I will send out and e-mail as a reminder.

We have had an incident where another club has been posting video clips on their team You Tube website showing their team scoring lots of goals and you can clearly hear the child who is celebrating first name. One of our Under 8 team's parents was not happy that their child might be on the You Tube website so when the team played Mytchett the Manager duly requested that no clips be posted on You Tube. A clip subsequently appeared but has now been removed. I have spoken to Hampshire Welfare Officer who advised me that the clips should not be on a social network especially as they were under 8's as their league are friendly games. Hampshire FA Welfare Officer said he would liaise with the Surrey FA Welfare Officer and request that the clips be removed. It would appear that they most of the clips have now been removed.

Mytchett Welfare Officer was very understanding and we received polite e-mails regarding the matter. However the Club Secretary advised us that we should take a look at the FA website regarding the matter which I have duly done. It states that videoing should be used as coaching aid and care should be taken when storing the film. It does not say they can be used on a social network. It does say the club can set up a website on a social network but must be managed in the correct manner. Martin has asked for copies of correspondence which we have received.

Steve Read – Coaching spreadsheet has been sent out – please let Steve have any updates. Please use the Hampshire FA and FA Skills Training Session that Steve sends out as they can be very useful.

Going forward the FA is working towards all managers and coaches having to complete 3 hours Continued Professional Development Courses to improve coaching across the board. Steve will update as and when we have more information.

Martin Castle – Finalising ties with Reading Football club for additional coaching. E-mail for Christmas and New Year opening will be sent out to Managers, can you please forward to parents.

David Austin – The better the club we become the more likely we are to have an inspection from the Hampshire FA. Please ensure that all your first aid kits are in order and that you all have the correct certificates.
