Graham Denny – no more problems with the referee issue. The referee concerned has been allocated mini football games for the time being.

Lee Bishop Under 8's Hawks everything is going well with the Hawks. Had a good match against the Jets. Lee asked for some generally football advice from Steve Read. Hawks were playing Mytchett on Saturday and asked where they stand about videos be taken of the team at games. Lee was advised that if he and his parents did not want the game filmed he was within his rights to decline.

Vanessa Baldwin Under 8's Jets – Vanessa is a parent of a player in the Jets who will attend committee meetings on behalf of the team. Jets are doing Ok no other problems.

John Doyle Under 9's – asked for some generally football advice from Steve Read. Steve to provide some new ideas for training in small indoor area to keep training interesting.

Carol Glanville Welfare Officer – CRB are still being processed for a couple of coaches. We have been advised by Hampshire FA that on line CRB check will be available. However the club will need a credit/debit card for this process. If an on line application is process the fee is £10 where as a paper application is £15.30. Over a three year period the club could save in the region of £300 and the application can take as little as four days to process. Dave and Martin to apply for a club card to process these applications.

Steve Read – Hampshire FA has supplied a Coaching Flow Chart of Coaching Pathways which Steve will put up in the club and see if he can obtain an electronic copy to e-mail managers and coaches. Martin Castle – Firstly would like to thank Steve and Fabian Fabian who are doing a great job with various teams.

Fabian attended a FA meeting regarding the introduction of 9 v 9 for under 11 in September 2012 which looks as if it will be introduced. Smaller pitches and goals will be required. We will wait for confirmation from the FA which will in turn be sent to Rushmoor Borough Council?

Martin will e-mail all teams and ask if any team will run into May for games. Martin has a meeting with Cove Cricket Club to liaise regarding when seasons start and finish and if there are any over laps.

Registration Fees and Fines are to be all paid by the end of January. Anyone still owing any money will not be able to play for their team until all outstanding fees and fines are paid.

David & Martin did a cash flow analysis of the referee fees. By the end of the season we will have paid out approximately £5,000 in referee fees. We will need to keep an eye on this situation and review it at the end of the season. We many need to increase fees by £5 per player next season. Bearing in mind that we are hoping to have the licensing hours increased when our Permission of Use Licence has been increased which enable us to hold function which in turn will generate additional income. This will still keep Rushmoor Community one of the cheapest in the area.
